

PUBLIC NOTICE

2011 TARIFFS FOR ESSENTIAL PORTS SERVICES

The PNG Ports Corporation Limited (PNGPCL) wishes to inform all its valued Shipping Agents, Ship Owners/Operators, Stevedoring Companies, Shippers, Importers/Exporters, Port Users and the General Public that the following tariff rates have been approved by the Independent Consumer & Competition Commission (ICCC) pursuant to the Regulatory Contract between PNGPCL and the ICC. These rates are to be applied by PNGPCL effective as of 1st January 2011 for its Essential Port Services of which the specific details are provided below.

1. TARIFFS FOR WHARFAGE SERVICES

The amount charged in the 2011 regulatory year for the conveyance of goods over the PNGPCL wharves, jetties, ramps, piers etc, is the tariff (rate per unit multiplied by numbers of units loaded or unloaded, as the case may be) will be calculated in accordance with the following table.

PNG Ports may choose to apply lower tariff if this is deemed to be appropriate by management and consistent with the developmental goals of a port.

Where: Tonne means one cubic metre.
Weight means 1,000 kilograms or in the case of bulk oils or petroleum, 1,000 litres.

If the unit is specified to be "tonne/weight", the applicable tariff is the greater of the tariff calculated on the basis of the number of Tonnes of the cargo loaded or unloaded (as the case may be) and the weight of the cargo loaded or unloaded (as the case may be).

Overseas Cargo - Inward means cargo to be unloaded from a vessel which cargo was loaded onto the vessel at any place outside of PNG.

Overseas Cargo - Outward means cargo to be loaded onto a vessel, which cargo is intended at the time of loading to be unloaded outside of PNG.

2. TRANSHIPMENT - WHARFAGE SERVICES

Transshipment Wharfage Services for Overseas 50% and Coastal 100% either Inward and Outward are to be charged and payable at the port of transshipment.

3. TARIFFS FOR BERTHAGE SERVICES

The amount that may be charged for the supply of a berthing service for the 2011 fiscal year in respect of a particular vessel is the tariff set out in the following tables:

Until such overseas cargo is completely unloaded at which time the vessel status will revert to being a coastal vessel.
