Proposed Harbour or Waterfront Development

PNG Ports Corporation is responsible for the management of declared and non declared ports and harbours nationwide.

This includes navigational, technical, operational and development activities as required by the Harbours Act.

PNG Ports is committed to ensuring that all activities including new construction and development of existing facilities and infrastructure are coordinated properly.

Individuals or companies wishing to carry out any development must seek endorsement from PNG Ports Corporation prior to seeking necessary approval from line agencies such as Departments of Lands and Physical Planning, Provincial Building Boards and the Department of Environment and Conservation.

After consulting these agencies, final approval must be sought from PNG Ports Corporation before any development or any construction work is conducted in a Port or Waterfront area.

PNG Ports Corporation in partnership with National Maritime Safety Authority and Department of Transport will be publishing materials for promoting navigation safety and procedures to ensure the movements, mooring and berthing of vessels is properly coordinated within our harbours.

We seek the support of all stakeholders in our continued endeavour to promote a safe, secure and environmentally friendly development of our port areas.
