PUBLIC NOTICE

TARIFF INCREASES EFFECTIVE 1ST JANUARY 2008

The PNG Ports Corporation Limited (PNGPCL) wishes to inform all its valued Shipping Agents, Ship Owners/Operators, Stevedoring Companies, Shippers Importers/Exporters, Port Users and the General Public that the following tariff rates have been approved by the Independent Consumer & Competition Commission ("ICCC"). These rates are to be applied by PNGPCL effective from 1st January, 2008 for its regulated essential port services under the Regulatory Contract between PNGPCL and ICCC.

TARIFFS FOR WHARFAGE SERVICES

The amount charged for the conveyance of goods over the PNG Ports Corporation wharves, jetties, ramps, piers etc, is the tariff (rate per unit multiplied by numbers of units loaded or unloaded, as the case may be calculated according to the following table.

- Where:
- **Tonne** means one cubic metre
 - **Weight** means 1,000 kilograms or in the case of bulk oils or petroleum, 1,000 litres
 - If the unit is specified to be "tonne/weight", the applicable tariff is the greater of the calculated on the basis of the number of Tonnes of the cargo loaded or unloaded (as the case may be) and the weight of the loaded or unloaded (as the case may be).
 - "Overseas Cargo – Inward" means cargo to be unloaded from a vessel which cargo was loaded onto the vessel at any place outside of PNG.
 - "Overseas Cargo – Outward" means cargo to be loaded onto a vessel, which cargo is intended at the time of loading to be unloaded outside of PNG.

2. TRANSHIPMENT – WHARFAGE SERVICES

All the Transshipment Wharfage Services for Overseas and Coastal either Inward and Outward are to be charged at 50% and payable at the port of transshipment.

- Where:
- PNGPCL wharf (ves) means a wharf in a Declared Port owned, operated or controlled by PNG Ports Corporation Limited.
 - A coastal vessel carrying cargo loaded at any place outside Papua New Guinea will be charged as follows:-
 - Overseas Berthage rate applicable.
 - Overseas Wharfage rate applicable

Until such overseas cargo is completely unloaded at which time the vessel status will revert to being a coastal vessel.

5. PASSENGER SERVICES FEES

K4.00 per adult passengers, children passengers to be charged half of adult fee.
