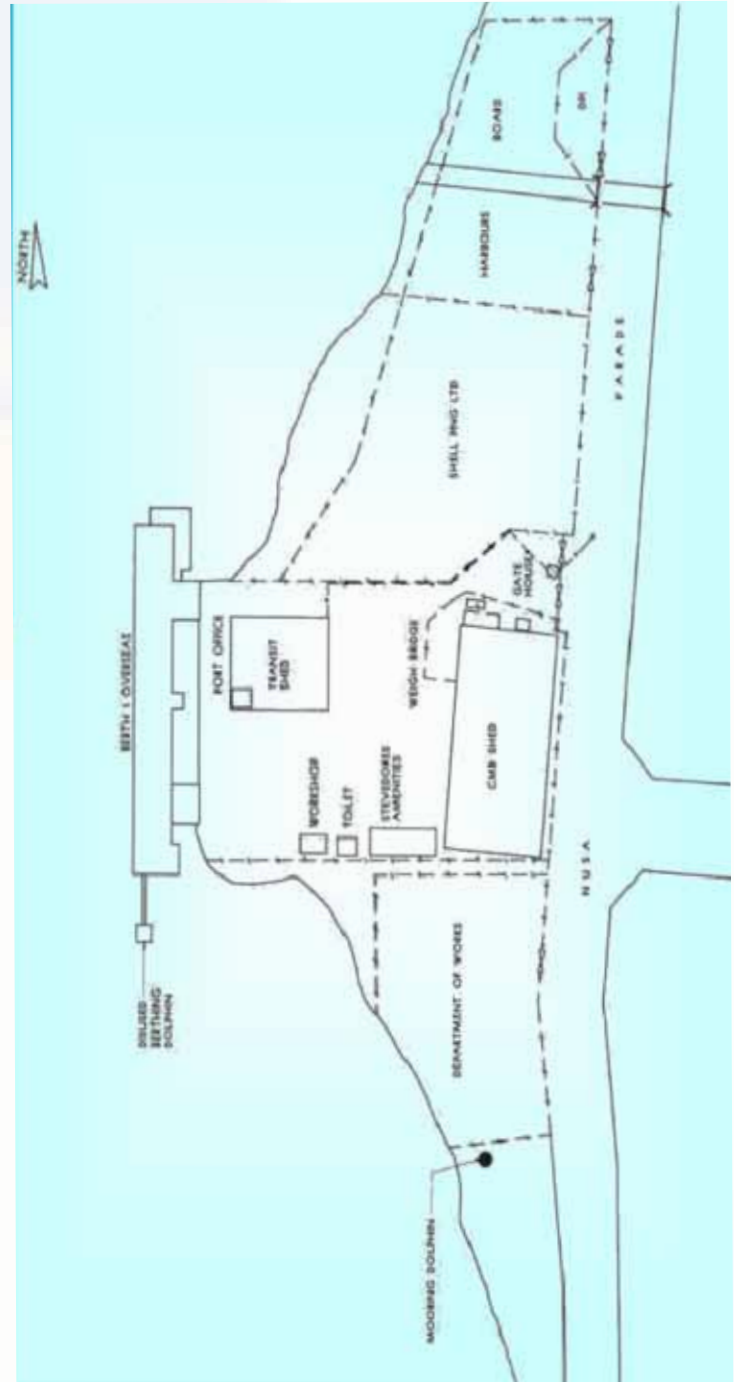
Waste Disposal
