



# SAMARAI PORT

**Samarai Port** is located off the south-eastern tip of Papua New Guinea on the island of Samarai. Samarai had been the former administrative capital in Milne Bay province. It is historically significant as the site of a trading port and stop-over between Australia and East Asia. Samarai town was established on the island and at its height was the second largest after Port Moresby in the Territory of Papua.

At present little is left of the town which covered Samarai as it was destroyed during World War II. The island was declared a National Historical Heritage Island by the government of Papua New Guinea in 2006.
